

## Internet-Based Business Activity Disclosure (T2125 Requirement)

If you earn self-employment or business income personally (reported on Form T2125), CRA now requires additional disclosure if any portion of your income was earned through online or internet-based platforms.

This applies to sole proprietors and individuals only.

It does NOT apply to corporations (T2 filers) or regular employees.

Please complete this section **only if you earned business income online**, including the following examples:

- Airbnb or VRBO
- Online stores (Shopify, Etsy, Amazon, eBay, Facebook Marketplace)
- Freelancing or consulting platforms (Upwork, Fiverr, coaching)
- Content creation (YouTube, TikTok, podcasts, Patreon)
- Ride-sharing or delivery apps (Uber, Lyft, SkipTheDishes, DoorDash)
- Affiliate marketing, ad revenue, or subscription services
- Crypto-related business activity (if operated as a business)
